

Summer Reading Program Guidelines

1. Registration begins Wednesday, June 1. Sign up any time from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM and get your Read for the Win summer reading book log.
2. Check out books from Macomb Public Library and read them at home.
3. Write titles and page numbers (if needed) in your Read for the Win book log.

Reading Requirements:

- Children up to four years old: 30 books read to them.
 - Kindergarten - 3rd graders: read 30 books. Every 50 pages of a chapter book can be considered one book.
 - 4th - 8th graders: 15 books (or 750 pages). If a participant reads 30 books (or 1500 pages) their name will be entered into a drawing for a bonus prize!
4. When reading requirements are met, bring in your Book Log and receive:
 - A certificate stating your achievement
 - A book compliments of the Macomb Kiwanis Club and Macomb Public Library
 - A coupon for McDonald's ice cream or FYI frozen yogurt
 - A small sports toys from the Macomb Public Library
 - An invitation to the finisher's party at Glenwood Pool on Sunday, July 31 from 6-8pm.
